Beginning at a 1 inch pipe at corner of stone wall at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Grant 1531 to Kaluapela and the Northwest corner of Grant 1373 to Kapunoho, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akihi" being 14154.8 feet South and 20399.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running by true azimuths:-

2. $144^{\circ} 40'$ 1347.0 feet along a 20 Foot Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $228^{\circ} 00'$ 1199.8 feet along Grant 819 to J. Kauhiahwa to a + on stone;
4. $327^{\circ} 25'$ 1510.0 feet along Grant 1531 to Kaluapela to the point of beginning.
