Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, on the East boundary of Lot 42, and on the North side of Upper Kalopa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 1864.7 feet North and 3016.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $196^{\circ} 20'$ 1353.8 feet along Lots 42 and 41 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $327^{\circ} 49' 30''$ 1436.6 feet along Southwest side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $28^{\circ} 17'$ 50.0 feet along West side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $88^{\circ} 00'$ 1122.9 feet along North side of Upper Kalopa Road to the point of beginning.
