Beginning at a + on rock at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 41 and on the boundary of the Forest Reserve, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $330^{\circ} 15' 30''$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $278^{\circ} 10'$ 579.6 feet along the Forest Reserve to + on rock;
2. $348^{\circ} 38'$ 1410.3 feet along Lot 43 to + on stone on the North side of Kahuna Road;
3. $70^{\circ} 41'$ 274.3 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
4. $75^{\circ} 21'$ 302.2 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
5. $82^{\circ} 23'$ 74.4 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
6. $96^{\circ} 56'$ 82.9 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
7. $174^{\circ} 56'$ 1638.4 feet along Lot 41 to the point of beginning.
