Revised Description.

Lot 42.

Hakalau Homesteads,
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 43 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 14312.3 feet North and 26.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 227° 45' 65.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
2. 217° 30' 298.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
3. 228° 25' 150.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
4. 328° 00' 1535.0 feet along Lot 41 to an iron rail 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream;
5. Along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 84° 08' 30" 547.0 feet to an iron rail;
6. 148° 00' 1153.0 feet along Lot 43 to the point of beginning.
