Beginning at a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot the North corner of Lot 42 and on the Southwest side of Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 178.3 feet South and 434.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 43° 50' 376.6 feet along Lot 42 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 133° 50' 200.0 feet along Lots 31 and 32 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 201° 20' 86.1 feet running parallel to Hilo Railroad track;
4. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 269.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:- 235° 41' 303.6 feet to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 313° 50' 170.6 feet along Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
