Beginning at a + on stone at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 43 and on the boundary of the Forest Reserve, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $334^{\circ} 11' 30''$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $275^{\circ} 09'$ 250.0 feet along the Forest Reserve to + on rock which is pitted on the North side;
2. $273^{\circ} 54'$ 424.3 feet along the Forest Reserve to + on stone on the West side of Piliamoo Road;
3. $357^{\circ} 21'$ 1529.5 feet along Piliamoo Road to + on stone;
4. $109^{\circ} 35'$ 274.4 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
5. $107^{\circ} 40'$ 296.3 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
6. $97^{\circ} 56'$ 250.0 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
7. $181^{\circ} 56'$ 1364.8 feet along Lot 43 to the point of beginning.
