Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot which point bears from a pipe at the end of course No. 11 of Lot 174, Kapaa Homesteads 4th. Series,  $179^{\circ} 01'$  85.8 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" being 15298.1 feet North and 4894.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2583, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $185^{\circ} 12'$  56.4 feet along General Lease No. 835 to a pipe;
2.  $268^{\circ} 51'$  80.5 feet along same to a pipe;
3.  $227^{\circ} 28'$  140.6 feet along same to a pipe;
4.  $256^{\circ} 27'$  155.3 feet along same to a pipe;
5.  $285^{\circ} 25'$  106.7 feet along same to a pipe;
6.  $14^{\circ} 31'$  47.4 feet along same to a pipe;
7.  $100^{\circ} 10'$  110.4 feet along same to a pipe;
8.  $59^{\circ} 37'$  301.1 feet along same to a pipe;
9.  $105^{\circ} 51'$  65.6 feet along same to the point of beginning.

AREA 70/100 ACRE .

Reserving to the Territory of Hawaii or its agents or assigns such right-of-way at all times and for all purposes with or without vehicles and animals across the government land (General Lease No. 835) to the land herein described, or any part thereof, such right-of-way to be designed by the Commissioner of Public Lands.
