2. $27^{\circ} 02'$ 132.1 feet along L.C.A. 6146Z apana 1 to Kahakamano;
3. $300^{\circ} 37'$ 29.5 feet along L.C.A. 6146Q to Hookano;
4. $210^{\circ} 30'$ 141.0 feet along L.C.A. 6146Z apana 1 to Kahakamano;
5. $113^{\circ} 41'$ 15.0 feet along L.C.A. 6146Q to Kaholo to the point of beginning.
