Station "Piliamoo" is by true azimuth and distance  $120^{\circ} 28' 384.6$  feet as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $282^{\circ} 45'$  382.7 feet along the Forest Reserve to + on stone;
2.  $349^{\circ} 11'$  1250.3 feet along Lot 53 to + on stone;
3.  $16^{\circ} 51'$  62.0 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
4.  $72^{\circ} 50'$  427.1 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
5.  $79^{\circ} 52'$  232.8 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
6.  $120^{\circ} 18'$  247.0 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
7.  $190^{\circ} 27'$  1438.2 feet along Lot 47 to the point of beginning.
