Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 49, on the Southeast side of Upper Kalopa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 3510.9 feet South and 6057.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $215^{\circ} 00'$  324.6 feet along the Southeast side of Upper Kalopa Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $200^{\circ} 00'$  311.0 feet along same to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $305^{\circ} 00'$  685.5 feet along Lot 53;
4.  $35^{\circ} 00'$  60.0 feet along Government Reserve;
5.  $305^{\circ} 00'$  60.0 feet along Government Reserve;
6.  $215^{\circ} 00'$  60.0 feet along Government Reserve;
7.  $305^{\circ} 00'$  630.0 feet along Lot 53 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
8.  $35^{\circ} 00'$  625.0 feet along Lots 52 and 50 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
9.  $125^{\circ} 00'$  1294.9 feet along Lot 49 to the point of beginning.

AREA 18-77/100 ACRES.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom an easement right from the Upper Kalopa Road to the government land reserved for the Government Survey Trig. Station "Lantana".
