7. $60^{\circ} 16'$ 88.1 feet along the road to a + on stone;
8. $80^{\circ} 35'$ 71.8 feet along Government Reserve to a + on stone;
9. $170^{\circ} 35'$ 465.9 feet along the road to a + on stone;
- + 10. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 585.9 feet along Lot 58 to the point of beginning.
