Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 63, on the Southeast side of Upper Kalopa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 13.6 feet South and 3119.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $305^{\circ} 23'$  938.8 feet along Lot 63 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $35^{\circ} 00'$  842.9 feet along Lots 62 and 60 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $125^{\circ} 00'$  1044.0 feet along Lot 59 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $248^{\circ} 02'$  95.0 feet along the South side of Upper Kalopa Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
5.  $218^{\circ} 58'$  771.3 feet along the Southeast side of Upper Kalopa Road to the point of beginning.
