Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 61, and on the East side of Papaaloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 912.2 feet South and 816.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 311° 15' 762.7 feet along Lot 61 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 24° 41' 483.5 feet along West side of Ochiro Camp Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 13° 15' 230.0 feet along West side of Ochiro Camp Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 131° 15' 1032.0 feet along Lot 63 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 223° 14' 30" 666.9 feet along East side of Papaaloa Road to the point of beginning.

Area 13-48/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way (10 feet wide) for a ditch across this lot, containing an area of 16/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 13-32/100 ACRES.
