Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 61, on the East side of Upper Kalopa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 13.6 feet South and 3119.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $167^{\circ} 02'$  741.7 feet along the East side of Upper Kalopa Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $295^{\circ} 29'$  1385.8 feet along Lot 65 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $25^{\circ} 29'$  742.2 feet along the West side of the Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $125^{\circ} 23'$  938.8 feet along Lot 61 to the point of beginning.
