Being Lot 63A of the Waiohuli-Keokea Homesteads.

Beginning at a mamane post on the East side of the Government Road and the North corner of L. C. A. 6179B:1 to Kalama, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali" being: 7779.0 feet South and 11353.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the East side of the Government Road to a point, the direct azimuth and distance being:
220° 57' 310.8 feet;
2. 297° 20' 290.0 feet along L. C. A. 6720B:1 to Nahelu to a mamane post;
3. 24° 24' 310.0 feet along Lot 63 to a mamane post;
4. 118° 28' 379.0 feet along L. C. A. 6179B:1 to Kalama to the point of beginning.
