Papaaloe Homesteads,
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Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 65, and on the East side of Papaaloe Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloe" being 2144.7 feet South and 1975.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 223° 14' 30" 485.3 feet along East side of Papaaloe Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 311° 15' 1245.3 feet along Lot 63 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 26° 43' 244.9 feet along Ochiro Camp to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 78° 18' 180.5 feet along the ^{top of} West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
5. 73° 19' 122.6 feet along the top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 131° 15' 1150.0 feet along Lot 65 to the point of beginning.
