Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 64, and on the East side of Papaaloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 2144.7 feet South and 1975.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 311° 15' 1150.0 feet along Lot 64 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 57° 23' 183.5 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
3. 28° 01' 210.6 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
4. 66° 01' 120.8 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
5. 31° 56' 40.0 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 131° 15' 1121.5 feet along Lot 66 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 223° 14' 30" 530.7 feet along East side of Papaaloa Road to the point of beginning.
