Beginning at a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe and ahu at the Northeast corner of this lot, the coordinates of which point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-A-Ao" being 1022.2 feet North and 1766.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2477, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 360° 00' 300.0 feet along Lot 67A to a galvanised iron spike and ahu;
2. 90° 00' 250.0 feet along government land to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe and ahu on the East edge of a grove of kukui trees;
3. 180° 00' 300.0 feet along Lot 66A to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe and ahu;
4. 270° 00' 250.0 feet along 30 foot road to the point of beginning.
