Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 66, on the West side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 233.3 feet South and 562.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $24^{\circ} 42'$  150.7 feet along the West side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $81^{\circ} 42'$  575.0 feet along the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $61^{\circ} 39'$  262.0 feet along same to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $205^{\circ} 29'$  684.0 feet along Lot 64 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
5.  $295^{\circ} 39'$  630.4 feet along Lot 66 to the point of beginning.
