Station "Puu o Kali" being: 6960.5 feet South and 11440.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 121° 19' 560.0 feet along L.C.A. 6429, Ap. 3 to Kaiwialii;
2. 214° 24' 420.4 feet along Government land;
3. 304° 40' 632.0 feet along Government land to road;
4. 10° 20' 380.4 feet along Government Road;
5. 116° 40' 235.7 feet along L.C.A. 6429, Ap. 3 to Kaiwialii to the point of beginning.
