Station "Puu-o-Kali" being 10724.5 feet South and 8696.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 290° 33' 330.6 feet along the Maui County Farm and Sanatorium to a mamane post;
2. 27° 58' 74.1 feet along the Maui County Farm and Sanatorium and old Kula Road; to a mamane post;
3. 7° 36' 188.9 feet along the Maui County Farm and Sanatorium and old Kula Road to a mamane post;
4. 114° 35' 382.0 feet along Grant 469 to J. Richardson to a mamane post;
5. 204° 57' 231.0 feet along Part 1 of Lot 73 to the point of beginning.
