to Naihehau, and L.C.A. 8404, to Kuhea.

Being land deeded to the Territory of Hawaii by the Paauhau
Sugar Plantation Company by deed dated Dec. 18, 1917, and re-
corded in Liber 488, Page 58, and portion of land deeded to
the Territory of Hawaii, by the Weha Agricultural Company by
deed dated Feb. 2, 1918, and recorded in Liber 492, Page 80,
in the office of the Registrar of Conveyances, at Honolulu.

Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North
corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 36, on the East side of
Gravity Railroad right-of-way, the coordinates of said point of be-
ginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being
1258.0 feet North and 1378.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey
Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $286^{\circ} 20'$ 1769.1 feet along Lots 36 and 33 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 321.0 feet along Kalanial Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $82^{\circ} 54'$ 191.5 feet along Kalanial Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $115^{\circ} 50'$ 729.0 feet along Lot 66 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $16^{\circ} 20'$ 396.0 feet along Lot 66 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
6. $106^{\circ} 20'$ 1070.6 feet along Lot 66 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
7. $205^{\circ} 29'$ 668.5 feet along Gravity Railroad right-of-way to the
point of beginning.
