Ili of Peekauai, Waimea Valley, Kona (Waimea), Kauai
Portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Waimea

Beginning at a pipe at the south corner of this lot, the west corner of Apana 2 of land conveyed by Kamehameha IV to Kaia, by deed dated November 30, 1857, and recorded in Liber 495, Page 368, and on the north boundary of Apana 1 of land conveyed by Kamehameha IV to Kaia, by the above mentioned deed, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "TRANSIT OF VENUS" being 1431.55 feet North and 1320.70 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2596, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-


1. 133° 00' 115.00 feet along Apana 1 of land conveyed by Kamehameha IV to Kaia, by deed dated November 30, 1857, and recorded on Page 368 in Liber 495, to a pipe;
2. 125° 54' 116.80 feet along same to a "+" cut in face of pali;

Thence along the foot of pali, along the Ili of Kikiaola for the next two (2) courses, the direct azimuths and distances between points at the foot of said pali being:

3. 243° 30' 42.80 feet;
4. 197° 30' 37.00 feet to a pipe; thence
5. 307° 00' 203.60 feet along L.C.Aw. 3608, Apana 2 to Kaniahe to a pipe;
6. 29° 00' 46.00 feet along Apana 2 of land conveyed by Kamehameha IV to Kaia, by deed dated November 30, 1857, and recorded on Page 368 in Liber 495, to a pipe;
7. 15° 58' 40.10 feet along same to the point of beginning.
