Beginning at a + on stone at the North corner of this lot adjoining L.C.A. 6147N Apana 1 to Kekona, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu Koa" or "Kahakuloa" being 1451.0 feet South and 1787.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1906, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $21^{\circ} 12'$ 30.0 feet along L.C.A. 6146D Apana 8 to Kenui to a + on stone;
2. $309^{\circ} 00'$ 65.0 feet along stone-wall along L.C.A. 6146D Apana 8 to Kenui to a + on stone;
3. $205^{\circ} 16'$ 24.2 feet along 10 foot road to a + on stone;
4. $133^{\circ} 12'$ 68.6 feet along L.C.A. 6147N Apana 1 to Kekona to the point of beginning.
