Beginning at a large rock at the North corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot B and on the South side of old government road, the true bearing and distance of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Opikoula" being: N 20° 09' W 1288.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2429, and running by true bearings:-

1. S 28° 37' W 892.0 feet along Lot B to an ohia post in pile of stones at the Southeast corner of Grant 1818 to Kalawaia;
2. S 74° 50' E 313.0 feet along Lot C to an ohia post on West edge of Kuhiwa gulch;
3. Thence down the West edge of Kuhiwa Gulch to the South side of the old government road, the direct bearing and distance being: N 44° 22' E 586.0 feet;
4. Thence along the South side of the old government road, the direct bearing and distance being: N 32° 19' W 531.0 feet to the point of beginning.

Area 6-45/100 Acres.

Excepting a strip 40 feet wide for new road which may be built through this lot, in which case the boundaries of this lot may be extended North to include all of the old road adjoining side (4).

Excepting and reserving the Kuhiwa Stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
