Notes of Survey.

Section 1. - Commenced at M. cut in the bed rock of the Punaluu stream, and follow up the stream which is the boundary of Punaluu and Mohokea iki.

- 1- West — 13.55 chains
- 2- North 59° West. 14.00 chains.

- 4- North 22 1/2° West. 10.00 "
- 5- North 39° West. 39.60 "

(North 12 1/2° East. 12.45 " across the land to X. at the old water ditch, bound of Mohokea mui.
- 7- North 52° West. 21.60 " along the Punaluu ravine.
- 8- North 61 1/4° West. 10.00 " to a large rock marked † in the ravine.

- 27- South 49 1/4° East. 32.12 " " " " " " "
- 28- South 42° East. 24.42 " " " " " " "
- 29- South 53 1/4° East. 28.00 " " " " " " " to X. cut in bed rock of branch stream,
- 30- South 32 1/2° East. 1.77 " " " " " " " to M. at the point of commencement.

Containing an area of 19 1/2 Acres, more or less.

Section 2. - Commences at the sea shore, at P. cut in the end of a rocky point on the boundary of Punaluu and run along said boundary

- 1- North 24 1/4° West. 2.70 chains, to X. cut in the pahoehoe rock.
- 2- North 2 1/4° East. 8.49 " to V. " " " " "
- 3- North 5 1/4° West. 9.22 " to a large rock at "Kalackoko", marked K.
- 4- North 38 1/2° East. 3.94 " to X. cut in the pahoehoe rock, on the boundary of Mohokea mui.
- 5- South 3 1/4° East. 22.50 " along Mohokea mui, Section 1, to H. cut in the pahoehoe rock near the sea shore; thence along the shore in a bent line, about
- 6- South 72 1/4° West. 2.40 chains, to the point of commencement.
