Railroad Right-of-way (20 feet wide) thru Lot 55, Kapaa Homesteads, 1st. Series, Puna, Kauai, the center line of which is described as follows:-

Beginning on the boundary between Lots 55 and 56, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the South corner of Lot 56 and the end of Nakeli Road, being $1^{\circ} 20'$ 208.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $83^{\circ} 48'$ 210.4 feet to point of curve;
2. Thence along a curve to the left with a radius of 637.27 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $71^{\circ} 35'$ 269.7 feet;
3. $59^{\circ} 22'$ 489.2 feet to point of curve;
4. Thence along a curve to the left with a radius of 1618.2 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $57^{\circ} 43'$ 93.2 feet, and the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at an angle in Lot 55 being: $335^{\circ} 53'$ 74.0 feet.
