Railroad Right-of-way (20 feet wide) thru Lot 137,
Kapaa Homesteads, 2nd. Series, Puna, Kauai, the
center line of which is described as follows:-

Beginning on the boundary between Lots 136 and 137,
the azimuth and distance to the Southeast corner of Lot 137 and
on the West side of Kamalu Road being $282^{\circ} 01'$ 499.7 feet, as
shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2452, and running
by true azimuths:-

1. $199^{\circ} 09'$ 332.1 feet to point of curve;
2. Thence along a curve to the right with a radius of 575.7
feet, the direct azimuth and distance
being: $204^{\circ} 30' 30''$ 107.5 feet;
3. $209^{\circ} 52'$ 173.9 feet to the boundary between Lots 137 and
138, the azimuth and distance to the
Northeast corner of Lot 137 being: 282°
 $01'$ 381.9 feet.
