# Territory of Hawaii.

Honolulu, T. H., March 9th, 1906.

Paaulo Homesteads, Hamakua, Hawaii.

Reserve between Lot 20 and Lot 21.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of this piece, which is also the Southeast corner of Lot 20, the true azimuth and distance from "Concrete Post" which marks the Southeast corner of Lot 21A being  $110^{\circ} 52'$  1056.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Reg. Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $194^{\circ} 16'$  1632.0 feet along Lot 20;
2.  $220^{\circ} 20'$  850.0 feet along Lot 20 to point on road;
3.  $24^{\circ} 09'$  282.0 feet along 50 foot road;
4.  $303^{\circ} 37'$  97.0 feet along 50 foot road to the Northwest corner of Lot 21;
5. Thence following the stream to the Southwest corner of Lot 21, the direct azimuth and distance being  $22^{\circ} 26'$  2120 ft.
6.  $110^{\circ} 52'$  1115.5 feet along Government Land to the initial point;
