Reserve between Lot 23 and Lot 24.

Beginning at a concrete post at a point equidistant from the Northwest and Northeast corners of Lots 23 and 24, the true azimuth and distance from the new Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapualei" being $305^{\circ} 57' 30''$ 4655.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $277^{\circ} 21'$ 100.0 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 23;
2. $15^{\circ} 51' 40''$ 2110.0 feet along Lot 23 to road;
3. $83^{\circ} 54'$ 213.0 feet along 50 foot road to Southeast corner of Lot 24;
4. $195^{\circ} 51' 40''$ 2155.0 feet along Lot 24;
5. $270^{\circ} 09' 40''$ 100.0 feet to the initial point.
