Beginning at the East corner of this lot, marked by a + on solid rock, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Grove" is by true azimuth $210^{\circ} 42' 30''$ 779.6 feet, Reservoir is $116^{\circ} 07'$ 454.3 feet and the Paia Mill Chimney is $138^{\circ} 18' 30''$, thence running by true azimuths:-

1. $47^{\circ} 09'$ 307.1 feet across gulch to + on stone;
2. $97^{\circ} 55'$ 247.6 feet along slope to + on stone;
3. $148^{\circ} 09'$ 341.9 feet down slope on across gulch to + on solid rock;
4. $218^{\circ} 11'$ 171.3 feet across flat to + on stone;
5. $290^{\circ} 09'$ 353.1 feet up ridge to + on solid rock;
6. $301^{\circ} 04'$ 249.1 feet up ridge to the initial point.
