This document is filed as Lis Pendens Document No. 368 and is on file in this office under Deed No. 7628.

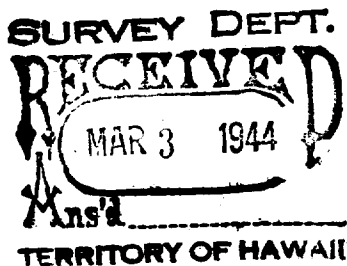
