Beginning at a stake at the East corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 11 and on the South side of Captain Cook Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Street Monument in the center of Lusitana Street and on the Northwest line of Alapai Street running Northeasterly being 520.24 feet North and ^{133.49}~~134.49~~ feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 45° 03' 120.0 feet along Lot 11 to a stake;
2. 135° 03' 78.0 feet along Lot 9 to a stake on the East side of Lanakila Street;
3. 325° 03' 110.0 feet along Lanakila Street;
4. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 270° 03' 14.14 feet;
5. 315° 03' 68.0 feet along Captain Cook Avenue to the point of beginning.
