Beginning at a stake at the East corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 8 and on the South side of Captain Cook Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Street Monument in the center of Lusitana Street and on the Northwest line of Alapai Street running Northeasterly being ^{763.70}~~759.84~~ feet North and ^{109.17}~~104.94~~ feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 45° 03' 84.87 feet along Lot 8 to a stake;
2. 148° 19' 102.75 feet along Lot 4 to a stake;
3. 225° 03' 61.3 feet along Lot 6 to a stake;
4. 315° 03' 100.0 feet along Captain Cook Avenue to the point of beginning.
