Beginning at a stake at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 9 and on the South side of Captain Cook Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Street Monument in the center of Lusitana Street and on the Northwest line of Alapai Street running Northeasterly, being <sup>646.46</sup> 646.64 feet North and <sup>31.50</sup> ~~8.16~~ feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $315^{\circ} 03'$  56.0 feet along Captain Cook Avenue;
2. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being  $00^{\circ} 03' 14.14$  feet;
3.  $45^{\circ} 03'$  128.14 feet along Lanakila Street to a stake;
4.  $148^{\circ} 19'$  67.8 feet along Lots 1 and 2 to a stake;
5.  $225^{\circ} 03'$  122.58 feet along Lot 9 to the point of beginning.
