Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 4 and on the South side of Bernice Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 787.15 feet North and 546.90 feet West of a Government Survey Street Monument on the Northwest line of Alapai Street and at the intersection of the center lines of Magellan and Captain Cook Avenues, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 343° 08' 30" 60.00 feet along Lot 4;
2. 73° 08' 30" 125.71 feet along Lot 2;
3. 135° 03' 51.33 feet along the North side of Captain Cook Avenue;
4. Thence on a curve to the right of a radius of 10 feet and for a distance of 20.44 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 194° 05' 45" 17.15 feet;
5. 253° 08' 30" 141.07 feet along the South side of Bernice Street to the point of beginning.
