Beginning at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 3 and on the North side of Bernice Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 965.71 feet North and 95.57 feet West of a Government Survey Street Monument on the Northwest line of Alapai Street and at the intersection of the center lines of Magellan and Captain Cook Avenues, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $153^{\circ} 51' 30''$ 76.0 feet along Lot 3;
2. $253^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 154.53 feet along Lot 5;
3. $324^{\circ} 34' 30''$ 65.21 feet along the Southwest side of Iolani Avenue;
4. Thence on a curve to the right of a radius of 10 feet and for a distance of 18.95 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $18^{\circ} 51' 30''$ 16.24 feet;
5. $73^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 153.55 feet along the North side of Bernice Street to the point of beginning.
