Beginning at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 2 and on the East side of Iolani Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 425.17 feet South and 351.95 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument on the center lines of Iustitana Street and Iolani Avenue, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along Iolani Avenue on a curve to the right with a radius of 318.5 feet and for a distance of 71.78 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $165^{\circ} 42' 71.63$ feet;
2. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10 feet and for a distance of 14.13 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $212^{\circ} 39' 12.99$ feet;
3. $253^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 91.62 feet along road to Summit Park;
4. $314^{\circ} 30' 30''$ 91.15 feet along Summit Park;
5. $73^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 148.35 feet along Lot 2 to the point of beginning
