

Beginning at the West corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 8 and on the North side of Kamamalu Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 617.37 feet South and 204.47 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street near Puowaina Drive, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 208° 48' 77.67 feet along Lot 8;
2. 298° 48' 168.19 feet along Lot 13;
3. 4° 09' 50.59 feet along Lot 12;
4. 94° 09' 138.36 feet along Lot 10 $\frac{1}{2}$;
5. Thence on a curve to the left along Kamamalu Avenue with a radius of 100.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 141° 03' 68.68 feet; to the point of beginning.
