Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 7 and on the Southeast side of Lusitana Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 432.17 feet North and 135.63 feet East of the Government Survey Street Monument near School Street and at the intersection of the center line of Iolani Avenue, the West side of Magellan Avenue and the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $309^{\circ} 11'$ 198.65 feet along Lots 7 and 6;
2. $39^{\circ} 11'$ 5.0 feet along the Northwest side of Kamamalu Avenue;
3. Thence along the Northwest side of Kamamalu Avenue on a curve to the left with a radius of 100 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $33^{\circ} 43' 19.05$ feet;
4. $106^{\circ} 57'$ 182.95 feet along Lot 9;
5. Thence along the Southeast side of Lusitana Street on a curve to the right having a radius of 543.7 feet the direct azimuth and distance being $200^{\circ} 43' 98.25$ feet to the point of beginning.
