

Beginning at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 4 and on the North side of Madeira Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 242.99 feet South and 504.59 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street near Puowaina Drive, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 208° 48' 75.00 feet along Lot 4;
2. 298° 48' 174.62 feet along Lot 6;
3. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 190 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 16° 45' 30" 66.10 feet;
4. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 72° 47' 14.38 feet;
5. 118° 48' 178.42 feet along Madeira Street; to the point of beginning.
