Beginning at the North^{west} corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 7 and on the East side of San Antonio Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 611.87 feet South and ~~4.81~~^{3.81} feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street near San Antonio Avenue, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 277° 00' 60.0 feet along Lot 7;
2. 327° 50' 67.88 feet along Lot 8;
3. Thence along Prospect Avenue on a curve to the right, with a radius of 120.0 feet and for a distance of 26.62 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being : 71° 43' 30" 26.56 feet;
4. Thence along Prospect Avenue on a curve to the left with a radius of 180.0 feet and for a distance of 53.2 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 69° 37' 53.0 feet;
5. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 20.0 feet and for a distance of 39.3 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 124° 04' 30" 35.62 feet;
6. 187° 00' 72.15 feet along San Antonio Avenue to the point of beginning.
