Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot, the North-east corner of Lot 13 (revised) and on the new South side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street at San Antonio Avenue, being 187.47 feet South and 1346.06 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2531, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. 281° 48' 79.83 feet along the new South side of Auwaiolimu Street;
2. 9° 21' 105.36 feet along Lot 17 of Block 29;
3. 98° 20' 78.45 feet along Lot 15 of Block 29;
4. 188° 40' 110.17 feet along Lot 13 of Block 29 to the point of beginning.
