Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 15 and on the North side of Puowaina Drive, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 433.80 feet South and 1386.30 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument, West of San Antonio Avenue, and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Iusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $189^{\circ} 21'$ 127.80 feet along Lot 15;
2. $278^{\circ} 20'$ 74.90 feet along Lot 17;
3. $9^{\circ} 14'$ 133.14 feet along government land (Chinese Cemetery);
4. Thence along the North side of Puowaina Drive, on a curve to the left having a radius of 315.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $102^{\circ} 24' 30''$ 75.26 feet to the point of beginning.
