1. 85° 40' 290.62 feet along Road 8;
2. 175° 40' 600.00 feet along Camp Site 2-B;
3. 265° 40' 208.22 feet along the remaining portion of Lot 9, Waiakea Cane Lots;
4. 167° 51' 605.60 feet along 20-Foot Railroad right-of-way to the point of beginning.
