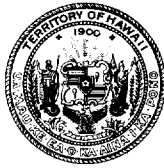

Beginning at a pipe at the South corner of this parcel of land and the East corner of Waiakea Camp Site 6-A, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 18512.6 feet South and 648.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2650, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. 151° 08' 113.20 feet along Waiakea Camp Site 6-A to a pipe;
2. 96° 14' 285.80 feet along same to a pipe;
3. 265° 40' 547.95 feet along the remainder of Lot 1002, Waiakea Homesteads, 2nd Series, to a pipe;
4. 331° 08' 50.00 feet along same to a pipe on the North side of Road "A";
5. 61° 08' 264.65 feet along the North side of Road "A" to the point of beginning.
