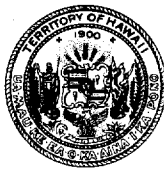
Being portion of Grant 312, Apana 2, to Kapahi, situate in the

Commencing at a point in the boundary between said Grant
312, Apana 2, to Kapahi, and Kawailoa, the coordinates of said
point referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station
"Kailua" being 4561.87 feet south and 10,239.82 feet east, and
running by true azimuths:

1. 320° 08' 00" 338.94 feet;
2. thence on a curve to the left
 having a radius of 130.0 feet,
 the direct azimuth and distance
 being 284° 34' 00" 151.23 feet;
3. 249° 00' 00" 138.83 feet to a point in the boundary
 line ~~of~~ between said Grant 312,
 Apana 2, to Kapahi, and Mehele
 Award 22, Apana 1, to Kainalu,

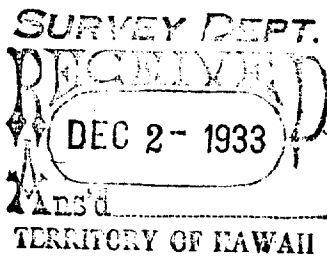
