1. 237° 05' 152.2 feet along L.C.A.10806 Apanas 32 and 33, to Kanehameha III;
2. 222° 40' 126.7 feet along same;
3. 325° 10' 103.0 feet along L.C.A.35-FL Apana 2, to Mahuka;
4. 59° 30' 80.5 feet along same;
5. 327° 45' 57.2 feet along same;
6. 44° 36' 116.3 feet along same;
7. 136° 46' 75.2 feet along L.C.A.1512 Apana 3, to Nalaweha;
8. 55° 04' 50.3 feet along same;
9. 132° 45' 80.6 feet along the remainder of L.C.A.1511 Apana 3, to Kanae, to the point of beginning.
