
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 804-A and on the North side of "Road 12", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 15292.7 feet South and 9466.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 804-A to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 2, Block 803, to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 180.0 feet along the West side of "Road 1 West" to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along the North side of "Road 12" to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 05/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 95/100 ACRE.
