Being a portion of Lot 8, Grant 6174 to William Henry,
of the Keaahala Homesteads, Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the South-east corner of this piece, on the West side of a 20 foot road, the same being the North corner of Lot 2, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "COOLIDGE", being 869.1 feet South, 1846.6 feet West, and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:-

1. 48° 00' 480.6 feet along Lot 2, to a pipe;
2. 114° 38' 188.3 feet to a pipe;
3. 236° 05' 672.0 feet to a pipe;
4. Thence curving to the left with a radius of 98 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 12° 33', 135 feet to the point of beginning, and containing an area of 70,271 square feet.
